

Spoon River Project

Thank you for purchasing tickets to our production. Below are some suggestions to help you better enjoy the experience.

The ticket(s) you have purchased is(are) for the designated performance only.

The Spoon River Project is a piece of theatre for adults. Children under 14 must be with an adult. It is not recommended for younger children. **No one under 16 will be allowed to the late night performances.**

1. Please Arrive On Time. Once the tour starts you may not be able to catch up to it.
2. **The dignity of the Lake View Cemetery must be upheld at all times.** No loud talking, No alcohol, No Food. Do not leave garbage of any type behind. Anyone breaking these rules may be asked to leave.
3. Please dress appropriately for the nighttime and for the weather conditions. Use bug spray if possible.
4. The use of Cell Phones will NOT be allowed once you have entered the Cemetery. Please turn them off.
5. Please stay with the guide. Do not wander off by yourself. Do not run. Please LISTEN to any instructions the tour guide gives you. If you are on a mausoleum tour you must pay special attention to instructions.
6. It is recommended that you use the bathroom before you come. The tour lasts approximately 45 minutes and the show lasts about the same.
7. If you need to leave your seat during the performance please seek an usher to help you to find your way.
8. RAINDATES: If the show for which you bought your ticket is RAINED OUT, You will be able to use your ticket at ANY OTHER FUTURE PERFORMANCE. There is also a planned rain date on the evening of Sunday August 2. Please check the Fenton History Center website FIRST at www.fentonhistorycenter.org. 9. It is suggested that you bring a flashlight with you, but you must turn it off when the show starts. Seating is not reserved. Seating is limited and will be on park benches. You may wish to bring a chair or cushion. Remember the show is after the tour, so you will have to carry it with you during the tour.
10. You will be guided out of the Cemetery as a group. Please do not wander off by yourself.
11. There may be torches, lanterns, firepots and other similar lighting possibilities that involve fire.

PLEASE do not touch or go near any lighting equipment.

Wednesday July 29th
And Thursday July 30th

Tour Starts at 8:30. Assemble at the Gate of the Lake View Cemetery, Buffalo and Lake View Avenue at 8:20pm. The Show starts approximately 9:20pm

On Friday July 31th

And Saturday August 1st - two performances each night. The first performance will be the same as Wednesday and Thursday.

For the second performance on Friday and Saturday the tour will start at 11 PM. Assemble at the gate, Buffalo and Lake View Avenue at 10:50. The performance starts approximately 11:30. No one under 16 will be allowed at the late performance.

Sunday August 2nd

The tour starts at 2 pm and the performance starts at 3pm. Assemble at the Gate of the Lake View Cemetery, Buffalo and Lake View Avenue at 1:45.
